From the Office...

What a fantastic summer we had! Everyone is back at school & now it's almost time for Thanksgiving! It's also time for monthly merit questions again! Great participation already! For those unfamiliar with monthly Merit Questions, here are the rules:

What are the monthly online CLH Merit Questions?

1. Merit questions are 10 miscellaneous questions in which your (prospective) camper can answer in order to earn merits throughout the year (**Sep-May only**). They submit their answers and then they will receive a reward postcard **IN THE MAIL** (letting them know how many merits they earned). **Save** all these reward postcards and **bring** them to Camp (if you have been placed to attend summer 2023). Turn them in to your counselor so that you will be able to go shopping at the "World's Greatest and Only Merit Store".
2. The questions cover all sorts of topics (e.g., animals, Camp trivia, sports, geography, current events, etc.). You can use books, maps, dictionary, the Internet, parents, siblings, etc. to help you find the answers. They are meant for the (**prospective**) **camper to answer** – either with the help of parent/guardian/family member/friend, **OR on their own**. At Camp Longhorn, campers do not need to bring money. Instead, they earn "merits" for good deeds/kind words each day of their term. These merits, along with whatever merits they received throughout the year, are all added up together so that they can go shopping at the Merit Store (or they can save them up for the following year, as well).
3. **NO LATE ENTRIES!** They are due at the end of each month. My only exception is that I will accept a submission up until the 2nd day of the next month in case a camper has completed them, but mom/dad forgot to scan or upload & email. For those who mail their answers, I will be able to see when letter is postmarked so don't worry if you mail your answers in on the last day of the month.
4. Merit questions are posted on our CLH website on the first day of each month. Go to www.camplonghorn.com & click on the "Merit Questions" tab at the top. Mark your calendar each month to remind yourself or your kids.
5. **Placed** campers and **waitlisted** applicants may submit answers.
6. Each correct answer is worth 2 merits for the possibility of earning 20 merits each month (that's 180 merits you could possibly bring to camp!).
7. Siblings must turn in one answer sheet per (**prospective**) **camper** or else I will have to give ½ **credit** to each sibling.
8. Remember, there are **TEN questions** each month so make sure you count **TEN answers** before submitting! Unfortunately, I must count unanswered questions wrong.
9. All three Camp Longhorns – Inks Lake, Indian Springs and C3, participate in Merit Questions for their own campers. Make sure you submit your answers to the correct contact person. For C3 (prospective) campers, email your answers to me at: cecilia@camplonghorn.com or mail them to me at:

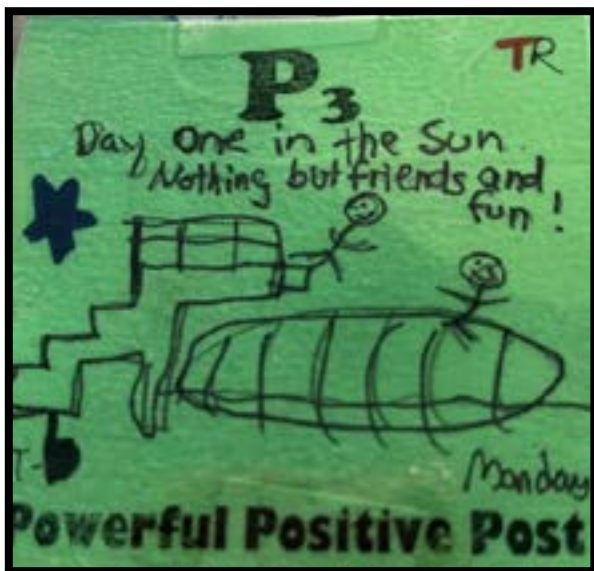
C3 Donates!
