Save all of these reward postcards (AND any other merits earned) so they can bring them to Camp in the summer, turn them in to their counselor & be able to use them to go shopping at the "World's Greatest & Only Merit Store".

- Each correct answer is worth 2 merits each for the possibility of earning 20 merits each month (that's 180 merits you could possibly bring to Camp!).


Remember, there are 10 questions, so I need 10 answers. Missing/unanswered questions are counted wrong.

For this year's Fall Bulletin, I am just re-running my piece that I contributed last Fall since I did not get many entries. I feel like this year there will be more participation!!!

#### Did you know...?

As most of you might know, orange and blue are the colors of Camp Longhorn—orange for boys, blue for girls. I have come to cherish this color combination greatly and have several CLH outfits and even a pair of orange & blue shoes I wear on Opening Day or V-Day. But did you ever wonder how Camp Longhorn chose these colors? The answer given to me by the Robertson family was so simple: Blue came from Camp Bluebonnet the name of the girls' camp their first couple of years! 




