**As we celebrate a decade of friendship and tradition, we are more excited than ever for the summer ahead. Here's to another incredible season of camp.....Attawaytogo!**

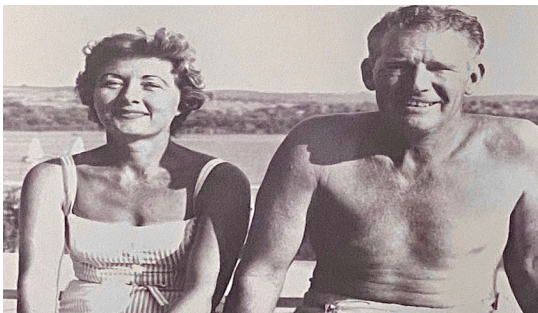
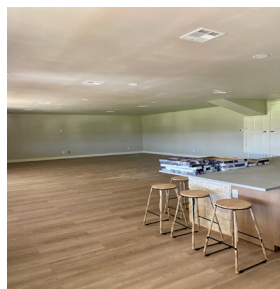




## From the girl's camp...
