

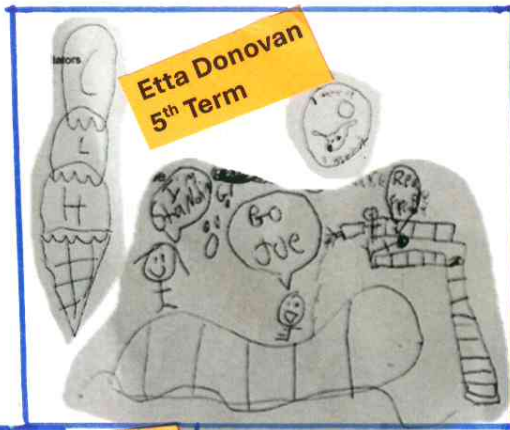


The magic of Camp is almost here and I can't wait to welcome each and every little girl into the gates of C3! ATTAWAY and see you soon!!!

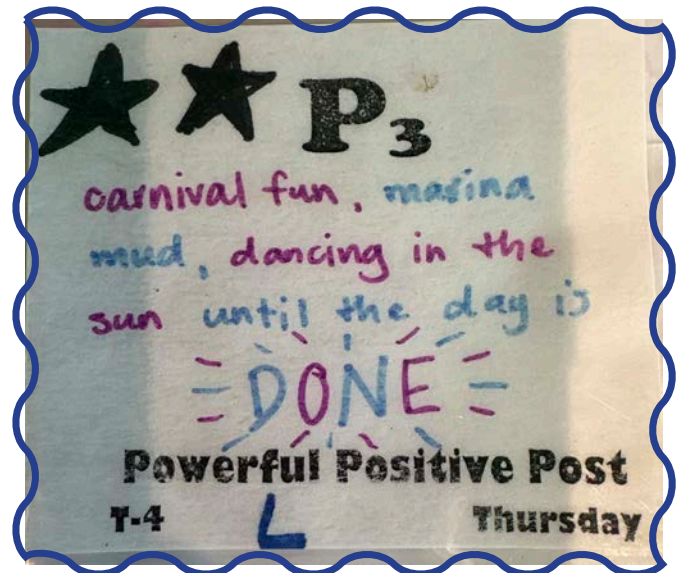
