We are ready and eager for summer 2024 at Camp Longhorn C3! The forms listed below are very important and need to be completed online and submitted by April 1st.

CHECKLIST OF THINGS TO DO

☐ **INVOICE: DUE APRIL 1**

Credit card payments are accepted at www.camplonghorn.com (VISA, MC, AmEx, Disc, PayPal). Make sure to keep your copy of the invoice for future reference. *If paying by check*, please return the TOP half of invoice with payment.

We encourage our campers to arrive by bus to camp. We may have added a chartered bus to your invoice when your camper was placed (campers living out of state/out of country are automatically assigned to the Austin Airport bus). For returning campers, the bus assigned on your invoice is the bus used last summer (new placed siblings will also follow suit). Please notify our office if you need to add, switch, or remove a bus. Bus changes must be made 7 days prior to term for a refund.

☐ **ONLINE MEDICAL RELEASE & AUTHORIZATION FORMS: DUE APRIL 1**

Campers will not be allowed to participate in ANY activity until the online medical form and authorizations are complete. Log onto www.camplonghorn.com using your *website code* (found on your invoice) and go to **My Account**. Click on **Required Forms** for instructions. If your camper is bringing medication (prescription or OTC), include this information within the online form. You will also need to provide current immunization records and insurance information.

☐ **TRUNK SHIPPING:**

Trunks are allowed on all buses with accompanying camper. If you need to ship your trunk to camp or back home, C3 has partnered with **Ship Camps** again this summer to help you with your shipping needs: <https://shipcamps.com/longhorn-c3>. It is a very easy process.

☐ **AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION FORM: DUE 2 WEEKS PRIOR TO TERM ATTENDING**

Any camper flying into the Austin Bergstrom International Airport has the option to ride on our Austin Airport bus that will bring them TO camp. You will need to complete our Airport Transportation form. This form may be downloaded at www.camplonghorn.com or call the office for us to email you one.

Make sure to read over online information on Camp traditions, policies regarding packages, and technology. Our office is staffed year-round. Please do not hesitate to call or email us if you have any questions.

START OF TERM (aka OPENING/INVASION DAY). CAR DROP-OFF: Our gates open Sunday afternoon between **2:00PM and 3:00PM** for those who are driving their campers to camp. Please note that we are unable to accommodate campers arriving before 2:00PM and that a late arrival delays cabin activities and pictures for the yearbook. **Please have any mail or medications ready to hand over to the Pit Stop staff.** Parents must say goodbye and let their child join his or her cabin. Should you have to arrive late, please notify us immediately so we can assist you in making alternative arrangements.

BUSES (see enclosed schedule):

The bus is optional, but we believe camp begins on the bus. We encourage campers by way of our chartered buses whenever possible as riding the bus to camp is a valuable experience for all campers. The bus trip is a great transition into camp and a Camp Longhorn counselor will ride the bus with the campers. **Please give any mail or medications to the bus counselor.** Don't forget, campers are limited to their footlocker, one laundry bag and one carry-on bag. **NO CANDY, GUM, OR COOKIES PLEASE!!** A chicken strip meal lunch will be provided for all buses except the *Austin bus*. If food allergies are a concern, please send your camper with a packed lunch. Please arrive to your designated bus location *at least* 30 minutes before bus departure for check-in, loading and saying goodbye. Bus cancellations made less than 7 days before departure are non-refundable.

END OF TERM (aka VISITOR'S DAY/V-DAY): V-Day is when parents come to pick up their campers. It is a special time for family, friends, and staff to visit and for your children to show off a bit during the 3 activities they will perform. Please arrive **no later** than **8:30AM** for parking, visiting and footlocker loading. Refreshments will be available for purchase in the Chow Hall, the Merit Store will be open for shopping, and prospective camper interviews will be held at our lake pavilion. **V-Day ends at 11:00AM. NO PETS PLEASE!**

DIRECTIONS: See map.

AUSTIN AIRPORT BUS (for flyers only): The Austin airport (ABIA) is the only airport we provide transportation to and from camp. There is no bus charge for campers flying in. Please make sure your Austin **ARRIVAL TIME** is between **10:00AM and 12:00PM**. CLH Staff will meet unaccompanied campers at the gate. You must complete and return our *Airport Transportation Form* (download at www.camplonghorn.com) with flight information and times **two weeks prior to your term**. If your camper is flying into the Austin Airport, we suggest shipping your footlocker to camp ahead of time (preferably 2 business days before the start of the term). Our shipping address is listed on the front.

New this year: Should your camper **need to fly home**, due to staffing issues, we can no longer provide transportation to the Austin Airport (ABIA) for terms in which CLH-C3 does **NOT** share a V-Day with CLH-Inks Lake & CLH-Indian Springs. These V-Day terms include **2nd, 3rd, 5th, and 7th** Terms. Should you need to make alternative transportation arrangements, we recommend [TEXAS HILL COUNTRY TRANSPORTATION \(512-790-8504\)](http://www.texas-hill-country-transportation.com). For all the remaining terms (1st, 4th, 6th), return transportation to the Austin Airport will still be provided. Make sure your **RETURN DEPARTURE** is between **11:00AM and 2:00PM**. Our camp representative is only available at the airport during these times.

PRIVATE PLANE: Private aircraft are welcome at the Burnet Municipal Airport. Due to the busy Opening & Visitors Day Schedules, camp cannot provide transportation. Rental cars and fuel services (100LL and Jet-A) are available as well as Texas Hill Country Transportation (512-790-8504). Call the airport at 512-756-6655 for more information.

CAMP TRADITIONS, REFERENCE & POLICIES

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY AND KEEP FOR REFERENCE

Parents, the below information will be helpful for your camper's happiness at camp. Please help us keep CLH traditions a strong part of your camper's experience.

BIRTHDAYS: We keep a record of birthdays and celebrate in a special camp way. Camp's traditional observance plus your gift (**no boxes**) and cards will make it the day it deserves to be. Please, **DO NOT SEND ANY FOOD, CANDY, or GUM!**

CARE PACKAGES: We offer school grade-appropriate care packages that may be purchased online in the store section of our website. (See "C3 Custom Care Package" for more details.)

CELL PHONES: Please note CAMPERS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO MAKE OR RECEIVE PHONE CALLS. Campers are not allowed to have cell phones while at camp. Any cell phones found will be taken up until the end of camp. CLH is not responsible for any lost or stolen items. PLEASE make sure your camper's cell phone is left at home.

Exception: Campers flying into camp may have their cell phone for traveling but must turn it in to the director upon arrival. It will be returned to the camper on V-Day.

DIETARY NEEDS: Please contact the camp directors and disclose on the online medical form. **For any food-related allergies**, please email our Chow Hall Director, Beth Cravey: beth@camplonghorn.com.

EARLY BIRD: Receiving your Early Bird is earning your invitation back to Camp Longhorn the following year. It is the biggest and most important accomplishment a camper can achieve during the term. Every camper has the opportunity to earn their Early Bird by being a friend, contributing to the cabin, and abiding by the Golden Rule. Early Bird letters for the following summer are mailed home one week after the completion of the term and will be available online to submit with a return deadline of **October 1st**. Early Bird campers are guaranteed a spot the following summer **in their original term**, as long as their application is submitted before October 1st. Any changes (e.g. term switch requests, address, etc.) can be noted in "comments" section.

ELECTRONICS: We do NOT allow electronic devices of *any* kind. Camp is a time to unplug and we appreciate your support. (See "Need List" for items not allowed.)

EMAILS: You can email your camper(s) by logging into your parent portal on our website. Please note, a camper cannot reply back via email. Emails will be printed each morning, with a **one-day delay**. Cutoff for emails is midnight. Please do not give out your personal website code. Send friends and family an invite through the "Invitees" section of your parent account, allowing them to have their own website code to email your camper. **Our messaging system will open at 6PM Opening Day of your child's term.** (See "Log on to CLH.com" info sheet)

FOOTLOCKERS & TRUNK TAGS: Most of our campers bring a footlocker to camp. If purchasing a footlocker, make sure it is no longer than 32" or taller than 14". (Suggested footlocker vendor links can be found on our website: www.camplonghorn.com/ParentInfo/Forms) Due to the limitation of space for baggage, campers are limited to 1 footlocker, 1 laundry bag and 1 carry-on (e.g. backpack). Footlockers may be carried on all buses but must be accompanied by the camper. You will also receive 2 tags per camper (color coded for Girls & Boys). Please attach one to your laundry bag and one to your trunk. Please contact us if you need a replacement tag or received the wrong tag. If your camper will need to ship their trunk home, please advise our office PRIOR to the end of the term so that we may alert our staff to prepare trunks for shipping home and bring them to the Office.

FUTURE CAMPER INTERVIEWS & TOURS: Interviews and self-tours for new prospective campers (for children entering 2nd grade or older) and counselors are available on V-Day at all 3 camp locations. C3 conducts its interviews at the tumble mats pavilion next to the lake.

LAUNDRY: Only available for our **two-week** terms. Laundry services will be provided once during the term.

MAIL: Remember, we have a **NO BOX** (only envelopes of any size/type) and **NO FOOD** policy. Please advise relatives, friends, UPS Stores & AMAZON of this policy. In case of any special mail situation or need, please notify our camp office: 512-793-2490 or email the directors. Feel free to send letters prior to your camper's term so he/she will have mail waiting for them. **Since we do not announce cabin assignments until 6PM Opening Day**, please include your camper's full name and term on letters. (See "Mail Call" info sheet for further details.)

MERITS: Campers do not need spending money while at camp. We use a Merit System and each camper can earn merits daily to save and spend in the Merit Store during their term shopping day. Many new campers have already earned merits from Interviews, Carnival, monthly Merit Questions, or a birthday postcard. Don't forget to bring those and have your camper turn in all their merits to their counselor!

INNERITANCE: Campers may inherit merits from Mom, Dad or Grandparents that attended Camp Longhorn! Leftover merits will be divided equally between siblings. A camper may "inmerit" up to 25 merits. Any merits exceeding that will go to the parents in the form of a gift certificate for them to spend at the Merit Store for THIS summer's V-Day **only**. We will issue the gift certificate by e-mail. The Merit Store will also have a copy of the gift certificate.

NEED LIST: We have enclosed a list of all items each camper needs to have in order to have a successful camping experience. Please label ALL of your camper's clothing, shoes and any extra items they may bring. Please adjust accordingly depending on a one or two-week term. The list also states all items your camper is not allowed to bring to camp.

PHOTOS: See "Online Photos" information sheet and "Log on to CLH.com" information sheet. Please keep in mind that a different cabin will be featured each day, starting with the youngest cabins. This means your camper's cabin may not be featured until the end of the term.

MAIL CALL

Mail Call is one of the highlights of the day! Campers enjoy receiving mail & email from their family and friends. Camp is a gift in itself. All three Camp Longhorn branches have a "NO BOX" policy. The policy was implemented to alleviate a messy cabin environment and competition amongst campers to write home for more packages.

1. Please, NO BOXES! Boxes of any size will be returned to sender. PLEASE NOTIFY FAMILY & FRIENDS OF THIS POLICY! If ordering packages from an outside source, make sure that company is also aware (e.g. Amazon).
2. Do not send any FOOD, CANDY, GUM, WATER GUNS, or WATER BALLOONS! Our mailroom staff will supervise all packages opened by your camper and unacceptable items will be taken up and donated to local charities.
3. Envelopes (ANY size/type) with small items are accepted. Please limit to only ONE package per week.
4. Please do not purchase gifts for the whole cabin.
5. Campers flying to camp that need to pre-ship their footlockers and a laundry bag will be allowed to ship their items in a box. We will hold the footlocker and laundry bag with bedding until your camper arrives.
6. Please notify our camp office for special mail situations or needs: 512-793-2490.

Writing letters is new to many campers. Many have never addressed an envelope or postcard before. Please make sure your camper can properly address an envelope/postcard or send pre-addressed envelopes or labels for your camper to use. Don't forget to pack the stamps!

Please feel free to send pre-written letters prior to your camper's term so he/she will have mail waiting for them. Since cabin names are not announced until Sunday evening of Opening Day, your camper will receive his/her mail regardless if it has a cabin name or not. Just make sure camper's first and last name are on the letter.

Also, the U.S. Postal Service is strict about envelope & postcard sizes. If you send stationary with your camper that is deemed as needing extra postage, it will be returned to us, thus delaying receipt of mail on your end. Make sure to include extra stamps if necessary. Tips for a Great Term!

Going to camp is an excellent time to grow and gain independence, confidence and make lasting friendships. Sometimes the separation from family, friends and familiar surroundings can be a difficult transition. Camp prides itself on its counselors and their ability to make camp a great experience. They dedicate themselves to helping your child learn how to adjust by keeping them involved and feeling like they are a part of camp. It is very important to camp that all children coming to camp have made the decision themselves. Because of the strong emphasis on the child's desire to come to Longhorn, prolonged homesickness is rare.



Please keep camp informed on any recent changes in your family. Divorce, death, serious illness or a recent move may still be unsettling for a child...or there may be nervousness of going away to camp for the first time. Any information that will help make camp the best it can be is welcome and strictly confidential.

We suggest writing letters that are newsy and focus on the things your camper is doing at camp. Lonesome letters about how much the dog misses your child or how the house just isn't the same usually contribute to feeling homesick. Include in your letters wishes of fun, good times and support. It is helpful if bad news can be withheld until you have your child at home. If this is not possible, please call us at camp and we will assist you.

When packing for camp, be excited and encouraging. You may send along familiar items that are special to your child.

Do not make deals with your camper concerning his or her length of stay. The commitment to cabinmates, counselors and themselves is an experience camping can offer that is unequalled.

We understand, as parents, that parents do also get homesick for their child. Just remember how valuable the experience is for them and how much they will have to share with you when camp is over.

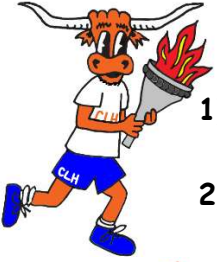

Log on to CampLonghorn.com

Parents don't forget to log on to the restricted section of the Camp Longhorn website, accessible only to parents and invited guests. There you can see photos, send messages, and catch up on the day's activities while your children are at Camp!

LOG IN! www.CampLonghorn.com/Account/LogOn. If you are new to the site, you must first set up an account. On the page that reads "Welcome to the Restricted section of the Camp Longhorn website" you will see the first choice of "Log in with your email & password". **DO NOT do this**. Instead, scroll down to where it asks you to "Log in with website code" and enter your website code (*which is found at the top of your invoice*). Then follow the instructions on setting up your account. If you logged in last year, it is also recommended that you sign in for the first time each summer by using your website code. Or you may use your email and password. (If you cannot remember your password, click the Forgot Password link and you can reset it.) **DO NOT** give out your personal code. To invite friends and family to see photos or email your camper, please see **Invitees** tab in your account.

MY ACCOUNT

Use the My Account tab to keep your email address up to date, change your password and sign up to receive email news and announcements from Camp Longhorn. (**For address changes, contact the office or email cecilia@camplonghorn.com.**) Here you can also manage:

- **BILLING:** You can pay tuition online using our secure payment system. We do not keep credit card information on file. **Visa, MasterCard, Discover, American Express and PayPal** are accepted.
- **REQUIRED FORMS:** Help your camper get ready for Camp and make sure we have received all the necessary medical forms and information. Camp Longhorn has partnered with CampDoc to allow you to fill out your *medical* information online. The Required Forms page has instructions on how to access their system. help@campdoc.com or 734-636-1000 for CampDoc Help line.
- **PACKING & TRANSPORTATION:** These tabs help you with all that your camper needs to bring to Camp and how they can get here! You can download a need list, view the schedules for charter buses or Opening Day drop-off, access trunk shipping services and airport forms.

MY CAMP INFO

Use this tab to check out photos of your camper, keep track of daily events and schedules, and share your camper's photos and experience with friends and family.

- **PHOTOS:** You can see how much fun we are having by viewing pictures of campers in action! Photos are a wonderful glimpse into Camp life for our families. A different cabin will be featured each day starting with the youngest cabins. This means your camper's cabin may not be featured until the end of the term.
