START OF TERM (aka OPENING DAY):

We are unable to accommodate campers arriving before 2:00 p.m. Keep in mind, a late arrival delays cabin activities and pictures for the yearbook. During drop off parents must say goodbye and let their child join his and her cabin. Should you have to arrive late, please notify us immediately so we can assist you in making alternative arrangements.

BUSES: *Please arrive to your bus location 30 mintues before departure time for check-in, loading and saying goodbye. Riding the bus to camp is a valuable experience for all campers. It is a great transition as Camp Staff ride the bus with the campers. Please give any written messages or medications to the bus counselor. Don't forget, you are limited to your footlocker, one laundry bag and one carry-on bag! A Chicken Strip Lunch will be provided on most buses, if food allergies are a concern please send your camper with a packed lunch. NO CANDY, GUM OR COOKIES PLEASE! Bus Cancellation Deadline is 7 days prior to term attending for a REFUND. **AUSTIN AIRPORT BUS: (FOR FLYERS ONLY)**

The Austin Airport (ABIA) is the only airport we provide transportation to and from Camp. There is no bus charge for those campers flying in, the return bus fee is \$95.43, and will include \$25 allowance at the Airport for food/snacks. Please make sure your Austin ARRIVAL TIME is between 10:00 am and 12:00 p.m. and your RETURN DEPARTURE is between 11:00 am and 2:00 p.m.. Our camp representative is only available at the airport during these times. *Airport Transportation Form(download at camplonghorn.com) please return 2 weeks prior to term

PRIVATE AIRCRAFT are welcome at the Burnet Municipal Airport. Due to the busy Opening & Visitors Day Schedules, CLH cannot provide transportation to camp. Fuel service (100LL and Jet-A) is available. DIRECTIONS:

Camp Longhorn Inks Lake - may be reached by traveling west from Burnet on Hwy. 29 for 10.2 miles. After crossing the bridge over Inks Lake, take your first left onto CR 301. The road leads to the Camp entrance on the left side of the road (one mile from the bridge). *If using a GPS system, enter CAMP LONGHORN INKS LAKE (see map insert for directions) Camp Longhorn Indian Springs - travel west from Burnet on Hwy 29 for 2 miles, turn left on FM 3509: Go 6 miles and look for the Camp Longhorn entrance on the left. *If using a GPS system, enter CAMP LONGHORN INDIAN SPRINGS 1000 Indian Springs Rd., Burnet, TX 78611.

END OF TERM (aka VISITOR'S-DAY):

V-Day is a special time for family, friends and staff to visit and for your camper to show off a bit during activities. The gates will open at 8:30 a.m. for visiting and footlocker loading. All visitors must stay in the car once the gates open until they have arrived at the designated parking area inside the camp. **NO WALKING IN!** The activity program will begin at 9:30 a.m. and ends at 11:00 a.m. Refreshments are available for purchase and the Merit Store welcomes visitors to shop any time during V-Day. Should there be inclement weather, check our website or Facebook for updates. V-DAY is the only time visiting with campers is allowed. Please advise friends and relatives. NO PETS PLEASE!

ATTAWAY TO COME TO CAMP!

Tips for a Great Term!

Going to camp is an excellent time to grow and gain independence, confidence and make lasting friendships. Sometimes the separation from family, friends and familiar surroundings can be a difficult transition. Camp prides itself on its counselors and their ability to make camp a great experience. They dedicate themselves to helping your child learn how to adjust by keeping them involved and feeling like they are a part of camp. It is very important to camp that all children coming to camp have made the decision themselves. Because of the strong emphasis on the child's desire to come to Longhorn, prolonged homesickness is rare.



Please keep camp informed on any recent changes in your family. Divorce, death, serious illness or a recent move may still be unsettling for a child...or there may be nervousness of going away to camp for the first time. Any information that will help make camp the best it can be is welcome and strictly confidential.

We suggest writing letters that are newsy and focus on the things your camper is doing at camp. Lonesome letters about how much the dog misses your child or how the house just isn't the same usually contribute to feeling homesick. Include in your letters wishes of fun, good times and support. It is helpful if bad news can be withheld until you have your child at home. If this is not possible, please call us at camp and we will assist you.

When packing for camp, be excited and encouraging. You may send along familiar items that are special to your child.

Do not make deals with your camper concerning his or her length of stay. The commitment to cabinmates, counselors and themselves is an experience camping can offer that is unequaled.

We understand, as parents, that parents do also get homesick for their child. Just remember how valuable the experience is for them and how much they will have to share with you when camp is over.

CAMP TRADITIONS & POLICIES

Please read carefully and keep for reference.

PARENTS, THE INFORMATION BELOW WILL BE HELPFUL FOR YOUR CAMPER'S HAPPINESS AT CAMP.
HELP US KEEP CLH TRADITIONS A STRONG PART OF YOUR CAMPER'S EXPERIENCE.

BIRTHDAYS:

We keep a record of birthdays and celebrate in a special camp way. The Camp's traditional observance plus your gift (envelopes only) and cards will make it the day it deserves to be. **NO FOOD, CANDY or GUM!**

CAMP TRIPS:

Beginning with the 6th grade group, campers are eligible for out-of-camp travel. These trips are limited to travel between the camps with the exception of longer special trips for the 9th and 10th grade groups. The Ranger Program, operated by Longhorn Rangers, Ltd, for the 10th grade boys involves extensive travel in Camp vehicles.

Receiving your Early Bird is earning your invitation back to CLH the following year. It is the biggest and most important accomplishment a camper can achieve during the term. Every camper has the opportunity to earn their Early Bird by being a friend, contributing to the cabin, and abiding by the Golden Rule. Early bird applications for the following summer will be available ONLINE one-week after the completion of term with a return deadline of **October 1st**.

Eighth grade and older campers must qualify for the Marine-Marina, Wrangler, Wrangler Chief and Ranger Programs. Because space is limited, there is a chance your child may be placed on an Early Bird waiting list for the following summer. **ELECTRONICS:**

Camp is a time to UNPLUG and we appreciate your support! Campers may NOT bring to camp any device that can play or record video, has internet capability, or may be recharged from an electrical outlet. This includes CELL PHONES, video players, digital cameras, iPads, Nooks or Kindles, music players or game consoles; GoPros or smart watches that have internet. Confiscated items will be kept in Directors office until the end of term. *Camp Longhorn is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.*

EMAILS & PHOTOS: Send your camper emails and check Daily Photos in the Parent Portal.

FOOTLOCKERS: https://www.camplonghorn.com/ParentInfo/Forms

We recommend trunks no larger than 13 1/2"H x 32"L in size. Due to the limitation of space for baggage, campers are limited to 1 footlocker and 1 duffle or laundry bag. **Footlockers may be carried on all buses, but must be accompanied by the camper.** If your camper is flying into the Austin Airport, we suggest shipping your footlocker via UPS or Fed Ex ahead of time. Our shipping addresses are listed on the first page. *Please note: 150 lb. limit for Fed Ex. To ship trunk to and from camp please use ShipCamps.*

TRUNK TAGS: 2 tags per camper. Attach one to your laundry bag and one to your trunk. Please contact us if you need a replacement or received the wrong tag. Print FIRST & LAST name on each tag. (No initials please).

INMERITANCE:

Merits from Mom, Dad or Grandparents? Your Camper must complete a form that will be in their mail box the first Monday of camp. Campers may inherit up to 25 merits each from Mom, Dad or Grandparents that attended CLH! Anything over 25 will be mailed to parents to spend in Merit Store on Visitor's Day.

MAIL: CAMP LONGHORN HAS A NO BOX POLICY. PLEASE NO FOOD, CANDY or GUM!

ALL boxes will be returned to sender even those from AMAZON. PLEASE ADVISE FAMILY & FRIENDS (This does not apply to trunks & laundry bags) Camper mail may be sent a few days before the term without the cabin name on it.

MERITS:

Campers do not need spending money while at camp. We use a Merit System and each camper can earn merits daily to save and spend in the Merit Store during their term shopping days. Don't forget to pack the Carnival Merits & Online Merit Question Merits!



MAIL CALL



Mail Call is one of the highlights of the day; campers enjoy receiving mail from their family and friends. Our "NO BOX" policy has been a blessing to alleviate a messy cabin environment and competition amongst campers to write home for more packages. Camp is a gift in itself!

- 1. NO BOXES Boxes of any size will be returned to the sender, this includes Amazon.
- 2. **ENVELOPES ONLY!** (Any size: paper, padded or Tyvek) with small items are accepted, please limit to only ONE per week.
- 3. NO FOOD, CANDY, GUM, WATER GUNS, SILLY STRING or WATER

 BALLOONS!!! Our staff will supervise all packages opened by your camper and unacceptable items will be taken up and donated to local charities.
- 4. Please do not purchase gifts for the whole cabin.
- 5. **SHIPPING A FOOTLOCKER TO CAMP**: We will hold your camper's footlocker and 1 box with laundry bag and bedding until your camper arrives.

- PACKING & TRANSPORTATION: These tabs help you with all that your camper needs to bring to Camp and how they can get here! You can download a need list, view the schedules for charter buses or Opening Day drop-off, and airport transfer information.

MY CAMP INFO

Use this tab to check out photos of your camper, keep track of daily events and schedules, and share your camper's photos and experience with friends and family.

- PHOTOS: You can see how much fun we are having by viewing pictures of campers in action! Photos are a wonderful glimpse into Camp life for our families. Each cabin will be highlighted during the term, with lots of group photos. This means your camper's cabin may not be featured until the end of the term. A **Photo Album** is available for you to keep your favorite photos from the summer. You can also order high-quality prints or digital downloads of those photos all summer long. See enclosed information.
- **EMAILS**: Good old-fashioned letters are always a great way to send word from home, but parents and invitees can also send campers emails from the **Messaging** tab of the Parent's section. We print the emails out each morning with a one-day delay. Campers will receive them at **Mail Call** Monday through Saturday. Campers are unable to reply by email.
- **INVITEES**: Be sure to invite your friends and family to use the above features. To allow them access to these restricted sections of the website, simply enter their email addresses into your **Invitee** section. They will then receive an email with a **website code** for their account.
