AUSTIN AIRPORT BUS: (FOR FLYERS ONLY)

The Austin Airport (ABIA) is the only airport we provide transportation to and from Camp. There is no bus charge for those campers flying in, the return bus fee is \$148.20, and will include \$25 allowance at the Airport for food/snacks. Please make sure your Austin ARRIVAL TIME is between 10:00 am and 12:00 p.m. and your RETURN DEPARTURE is between 11:00 am and 2:00 p.m.. Our camp representative is only available at the airport during these times.

DIRECTIONS:

Camp Longhorn Inks Lake - may be reached by traveling west from Burnet on Hwy. 29 for 10.2 miles. After crossing the bridge over Inks Lake, take your first left onto CR 301. The road leads to the Camp entrance on the left side of the road (one mile from the bridge). *If using a GPS system, enter CAMP LONGHORN INKS LAKE (see map insert for directions) Camp Longhorn Indian Springs - travel west from Burnet on Hwy 29 for 2 miles, turn left on FM 3509: Go 6 miles and look for the Camp Longhorn entrance on the left. *If using a GPS system, enter CAMP LONGHORN INDIAN SPRINGS 1000 Indian Springs Rd., Burnet, TX 78611.

It is the biggest and most important accomplishment a camper can achieve during the term. Every camper has the opportunity to earn their Early Bird by being a friend, contributing to the cabin, and abiding by the Golden Rule. Early bird applications for the following summer will be available ONLINE one-week after the completion of term with a return deadline of October 1st. Eighth grade and older campers must qualify for the Marine-Marina, Wrangler, Wrangler Chief and Ranger Programs. Because space is limited, there is a chance your child may be placed on an Early Bird waiting list for the following summer. ELECTRONICS: Camp is a time to UNPLUG and we appreciate your support! Campers may NOT bring to camp any device that can play or record video, has internet capability, or may be recharged from an electrical outlet. This includes CELL PHONES, video players, digital cameras, iPads, Nooks or Kindles, music players or game consoles; GoPros or smart watches that have internet. Confiscated items will be kept in Directors office until the end of term. Camp Longhorn is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

<u>EMAILS & PHOTOS:</u> You can email your camper by logging into your Parent Portal. Please note, a camper cannot reply back via email. Emails will be printed each morning, with a one-day delay, as Cut off for emails is midnight. Our messaging system will open at 6pm on Opening Day and close the last Thursday at Midnight.

We recommend trunks no larger than 13 1/2"H x 32"L in size. Due to the limitation of space for baggage, campers are limited to 1 footlocker and 1 duffle or laundry bag. **Footlockers may be carried on all buses, but must be accompanied by the camper.** *Please note:* 85 *lb. limit to ship trunk to and from camp using ShipCamps.*

<u>LAUNDRY:</u> Laundry service will be provided to each cabin twice a term. Please make sure to label all clothing.

<u>TRUNK TAGS:</u> 2 tags per camper. Attach one to your laundry bag and one to your trunk. Please contact us if you need a replacement or received the wrong tag. Print FIRST & LAST name on each tag. (No initials please).

<u>INMERITANCE:</u> Merits from Mom, Dad or Grandparents? Your Camper must complete a form that will be in their mail box the first Monday of camp. Campers may inherit up to 25 merits each from Mom, Dad or Grandparents that attended CLH! Anything over 25 will be mailed to parents to spend in Merit Store on Visitor's Day.

MAIL: NO BOXES = ENVELOPES ONLY. PLEASE NO FOOD, CANDY,GUM, SUNFLOWER SEEDS, ETC!
ALL boxes will be returned to sender even those from AMAZON. (This does not apply to trunks & laundry bags) Camper mail may be sent a few days before the term without the cabin name on it. PLEASE ADVISE FAMILY & FRIENDS!!!!

Tips for a Great Term!

Going to camp is an excellent time to grow and gain independence, confidence and make lasting friendships. Sometimes the separation from family, friends and familiar surroundings can be a difficult transition. Camp prides itself on its counselors and their ability to make camp a great experience. They dedicate themselves to helping your child learn how to adjust by keeping them involved and feeling like they are a part of camp. It is very important to camp that all children coming to camp have made the decision themselves. Because of the strong emphasis on the child's desire to come to Longhorn, prolonged homesickness is rare.



Please keep camp informed on any recent changes in your family. Divorce, death, serious illness or a recent move may still be unsettling for a child...or there may be nervousness of going away to camp for the first time. Any information that will help make camp the best it can be is welcome and strictly confidential.

We suggest writing letters that are newsy and focus on the things your camper is doing at camp. Lonesome letters about how much the dog misses your child or how the house just isn't the same usually contribute to feeling homesick. Include in your letters wishes of fun, good times and support. It is helpful if bad news can be withheld until you have your child at home. If this is not possible, please call us at camp and we will assist you.

When packing for camp, be excited and encouraging. You may send along familiar items that are special to your child.

Do not make deals with your camper concerning his or her length of stay. The commitment to cabinmates, counselors and themselves is an experience camping can offer that is unequaled.

We understand, as parents, that parents do also get homesick for their child. Just remember how valuable the experience is for them and how much they will have to share with you when camp is over.



Mail Call



Mail Call is one of the highlights of the day; campers enjoy receiving mail from their family and friends. Our "NO BOX" policy has been a blessing to alleviate a messy cabin environment and competition amongst campers to write home for more packages. Camp is a gift in itself!

- 1. **NO BOXES** Boxes of any size will be returned to the sender, this includes Amazon.
- 2. **ENVELOPES ONLY!** (Any size: paper, padded or Tyvek) with small items are accepted, please limit to only ONE per week.
