## THE WORLD'S GREATEST MERIT STORES!

Meet Susan Wilhelmi, President of the World's Greatest Merit Store at CLH Indian Springs. My husband Don had been a counselor at Inks Lake since 1972. We got married in 1974 and Tex told Don, bring your wife and that's how it all began!

My first year at Camp Longhorn was in 1975. That summer we were at Inks Lake. I helped MF Johnson in the Annual office, typing and proofing pages. The next summer, in 1976, Don and I were asked to help Mary Patt and Frank Everest at the new camp, then called "Ranch Branch". I worked in the office and did anything that needed to be done.

In 1977, the Ranch was going to have its very own Merit Store and Tex asked me to be president. The first store was a small, screened-in cabin above the chow hall. It started more like a mail-order store. We only stocked one or two of each item. If we needed more we'd order from Inks. But as camp grew so did the Merit Store. When the Chow Hall expanded downstairs, the Merit store expanded upstairs. Some version of the Merit Store was located above the Chow Hall from 1977 to 2016. Then in 2017, we moved into the wonderful, spacious building where we are today. I have so many fun and fond memories of how things have changed, but one stands out:

At the end of every summer, I would have to pack up the Merit Store for storage. One summer I had just one Elmer Fudd figurine left. Elmer Fudd is one of the first items we stocked in the store, so I thought he needed a place of honor. We made him a display case out of stuff we found in the merit store – a clear jewelry box case turned on end with a clear plastic base for riser. He's still displayed in the Merit Store today! Seeing Elmer Fudd in his display case helps me to remember where we started! We've come a long way. Sometimes it was hard and crowded but I wouldn't change one thing!

I have had so many wonderful counselors, aka Vice Presidents, help me throughout the years. I wish I could name them all here! You know who you are! I still get to get a hug from some of them on Visitor's Day and it's especially fun to meet their campers! So many wonderful friendships. I've been so blessed!

Judy Roundtree had been my VP for the last eighteen years. She retired in August to spend time with her 6 grand-



children. Wendy Keele, who had helped us in the summer for the last six years, has come on board FULL TIME to be the new VP. A little background on me. I graduated from McNeese State University with a teaching degree in 1974. I taught school for 28 years. For the last 48 years I have spent my entire summers at camp. Both of my parents attended the University of Texas at Austin, which made us a loyal Texas Longhorn family. When my mother first mentioned Camp Longhorn to me when I was 7 years old, I just assumed it was tied to the University of Texas in some way so I was immediately interested and wanted to know more about it. My sister had attended 2nd Term Girls Main Camp for her first year in 1979 and I remember arriving to pick her up in Burnet with my parents on V-Day. Being from the rural town of Mexia, Texas, I had never seen, nor could I have ever imagined such a captivating place with water slides, lake swimming lanes, outdoor games, water activities and of course, The Blob. On the way home, I heard all her Camp stories, and she talked in a secret language, mentioning libraries, Frog Day, Pit Stop, Chow and other terms I did not understand, but I could tell she had one of the best times of her life! I knew I wanted to have

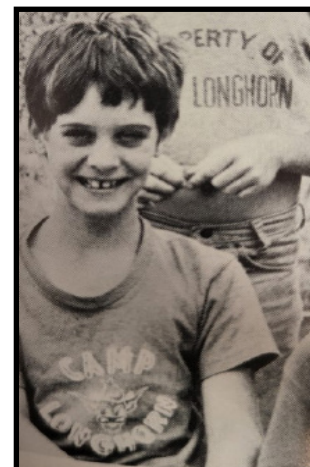
that experience and couldn't wait to have an opportunity to attend Camp Longhorn as a camper.

So on a cold January day in 1980, I attended my first Carnival in Corsicana, Texas. I had been placed on the camp waiting list, but I was going to Carnival for my camp interview. I played all the games, laughed at all the puns and watched the camp movie on a portable projector screen from a reel projector. Then came the magic number drawing for prizes! I saw many win Camp Longhorn Salos, banners and other camp prizes, heard stories about Tex, but my number was never called during the preliminary drawings. But then the camp Rulers mentioned a grand prize drawing for an AM/FM portable radio! My dad's El Camino only had AM radio so I really wanted to win that prize as FM radio was a premium. Well, the Camp Longhorn guardians were looking down on me that day and my number was called, and I was the proud owner of a 6"x4" AM/FM portable radio! This was a big deal for a kid in 1980 and I was on top of the world!

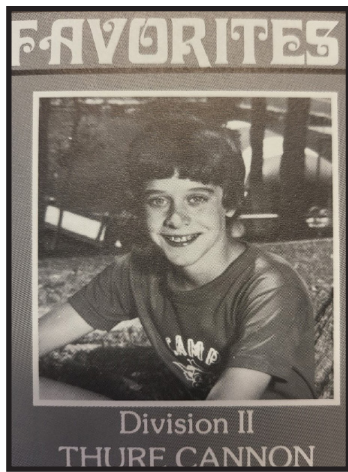
But then came the bad news from the interview, or so I thought at that time. The directors said the interview went great, and they would love to have me at Camp, but there was not room for my age at Boys Main. However, they went on to sell the wares of a place called Camp Longhorn - Ranch Branch, which included "Hossback" riding (something that Main didn't have), the tallest and longest trolley at either camp, joint Campfire and Chow with Girls Camp and they assured me that the Blob performed the same at Ranch as it did at Main. Still elated from the big radio win and persuaded by Camp's expert negotiators, I immediately accepted their offer for 1st Term Ranch Branch Boys and I still consider that one of the best, and most significant decisions in the entirety of my life! Seriously!

For the next 7 summers, the best three weeks of my year was spent at Camp. It was a place that made one feel special, and taught campers how to be a friend to everyone regardless of any varying interests one may have. It was a place where a kid could truly be themselves and while there was ample personal responsibility, it let one's personality foster, grow and shine. Every year I was blessed to make new friends, and the bonds with old friends only became stronger. The friends I made at Camp are some of my closest and most trusted, and have positively influenced my path throughout life.

After finishing up as a camper, I was honored to become a counselor at Camp Longhorn. It remains as one of the most rewarding jobs I have ever done. For all but one term as a counselor, I was in the Rattlesnake Cabin which is the 1st year cabin at Indian Springs. Watching the sheer joy on the faces of first year campers jump on the Blob for the first time, go to their first Dance Night or goof around with their cabinmates at activities was a phenomenal experience that truly illustrates what



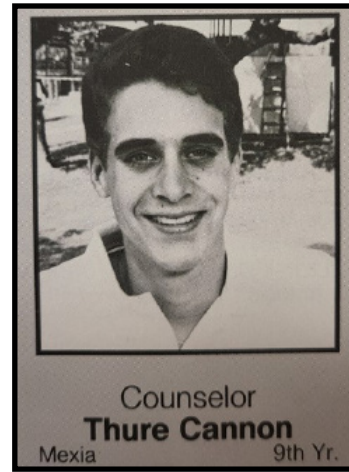
1980 1st Term Rattlesnake

The warm giant welcome that comes from this moment, makes all the butterflies go away. One of the first things I learned when arriving at camp is that everybody is somebody. I didn't know this would mold and shape me into who I am today. Camp teaches you so much about respect, self respect, and respect for others. It instills confidence and allows you to be who you are without any judgment. It taught me how to develop and maintain close friendships. I wasn't intending on creating a nine year friendship with three girls who have been by my side through everything, even living over a 1,000 miles away. This special place leads me towards my future bridesmaids, longtime friends, and the important things in life. I didn't realize that over nine summers I was developing some of the most important life skills, friendships, and treasured memories that will always be with me. No matter where my journey in life takes me, I know I will always have these things to wrap myself in because they're like a blanket in the comforts of home. When I return as a counselor, my goal is to create that same magical, life changing experience that was created for me, for all the kids that come through those gates.

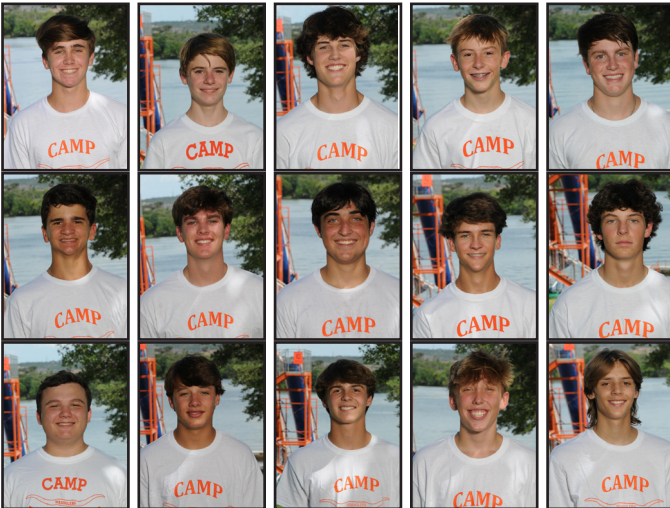

It starts in January, with the reserving of a rental car and plane tickets for "Drop Day". I love renting a really big SUV, so at least for a weekend, I can feel like I live

During those three weeks, my days are filled with house projects back in California, but each day has its own countdown to when pictures are uploaded and emails go out each evening. Friends and neighbors come over to share in the kids' experiences. By the start of week three, I have begun the shutdown and readying of logistics to make my trek to Austin with my Big Mac (massive Golden Retriever). Once we hop in the van to start the journey back to Texas, the country music gets locked in. We rock and roll over the course of two days, with our planned rejoicing dip in Ink's lake before anywhere else. The Thursday and Friday pre V-Day are filled with fellow parents arriving and getting together to celebrate the good times and the adventures we have witnessed and heard about over the previous three weeks.

Then...bam! V-Day. A four o'clock awakening of excitement and emotions. I pride myself on being top 20 in the line cars if possible. Marty (Diana's husband) and I usually like to throw a little football around, but we are always entertained by the parents walking the lines of cars, looking for friends and family, drinking coffee or other (?) beverages, and talking about old times and new. And then, like Charlie and The Chocolate Factory, we are welcomed into the gates of this magical place that our most important things is this world, our children, have played, learned, and grown in individually as well as together as people. With tears trying to be held back, I run to my kids as though it has been years. And for an hour or so, me...the outsider, gets to live vicariously through their eyes and experience Camp Longhorn and the experiences that were had.

Why am I giving you the behind the scenes of my world during Camp? Why have I babbled on, trying to put into words the jumbled excitement, nervousness, fear, and joy that I experience in these three weeks every year? Because I want you to know that Camp Longhorn isn't just for the campers. Everyone has stories, and you are creating stories that have and will last generations. To me, that is simply magical, and you should be extremely proud of what you and your family have created for literally thousands of people, young and old.

I'll be honest, these last few days of Camp are always "bittersweet" for me. It's "sweet" that more experiences and stories will be in the books. It's sweet that I was able to once again rent a big SUV in Texas. It's sweet that Mac and I again made our trek safely and were able to wash off the year's craziness in education in the waters at Ink's. But it's "bitter" that it's coming to a close. It's a bit bitter that the next camp is so far away in time. And it's bitter that the annual cycle in only at its starting point, forcing us to look to the horizon once again.

To bring this full circle, Camp Longhorn is a beacon of the year for many of us. In this crazy world of COVID, shootings, politics, and what seems to be a growing global unrest, we need Camp Longhorn more than ever. The future is not tomorrow, it's now, and it starts with us, most importantly our youth, and there is no better place on the planet to instill positive values, life lessons, and skills than at Camp Longhorn.

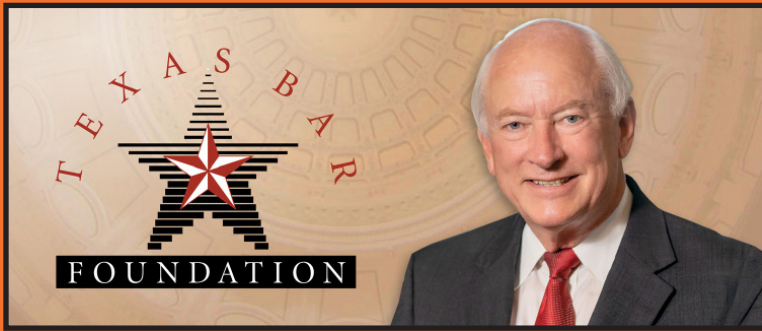

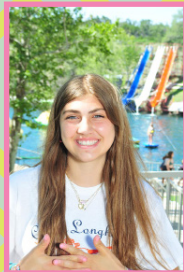

## CONGRATULATIONS BRANT MARTIN!

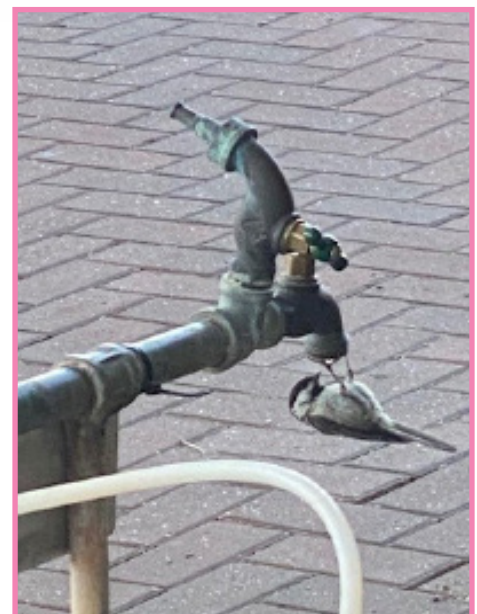
Brant Martin appeared before the U.S. Supreme Court to present argument on behalf of Ysleta del Sur Pueblo in the case of Ysleta del Sur Pueblo, et al v. State of Texas. US Supreme Court sided with El Paso's Tigua tribe in decades-long gambling fight with Texas. The decision is a major victory for the Tiguas, formally known as the Ysleta del Sur Pueblo, in their three-decade fight with the state of Texas over gambling. The legal fight between Texas and the Tiguas started in the early 1990s, when the tribe tried to expand gambling on its land and the state continuously went to federal court to block those efforts.

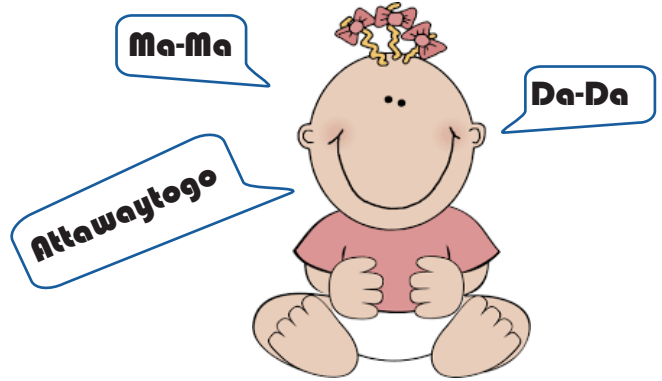

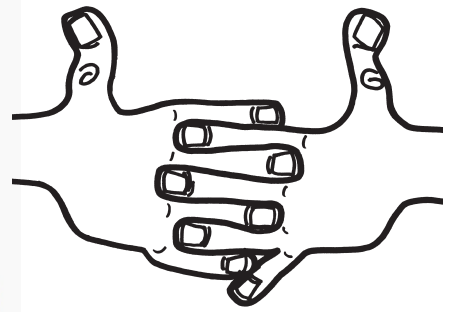


EVELYN "EVIE" MARIE CHRISTY

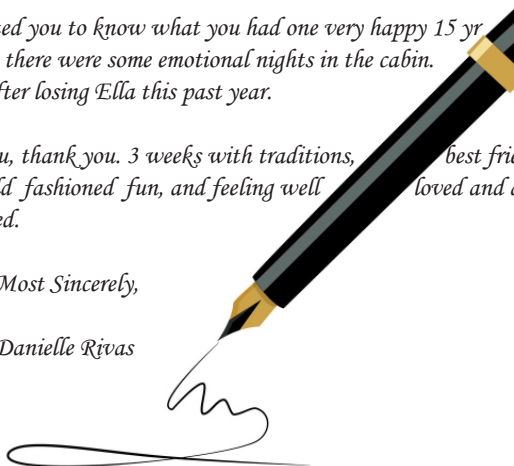

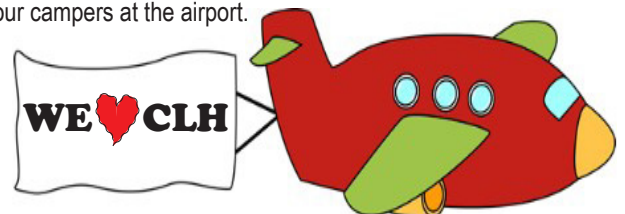

April 14, 2008 - September 2, 2022

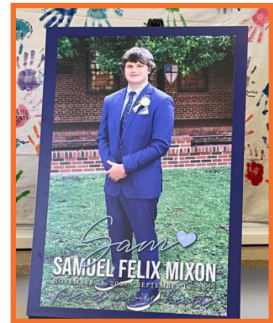
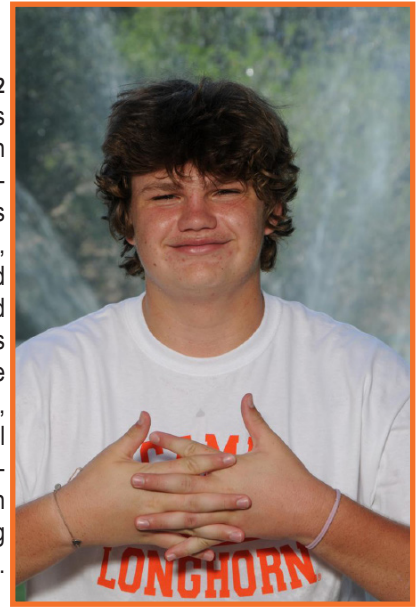

*stories. So much history of the earlier days of all of ours' favorite summer home is in her memory banks. Tex's entrepreneurial building of Camp Longhorn is legendary. First Boy's Camp Director Bill Johnson's memoir and grandson Ross Lucksinger's The Father of Texas Swimming*

*contain stories about Tex's ingenuity and the origins of Camp. However, Helen, who spent more than a half of century at both campuses, and her knowledge of Camp history are also equally as impressive and entertaining. We covered so many topics, and now as I write this piece a month later, I can't remember all of them. One she shared after I told her about the driveway signs Suzanne and I had encountered when we unknowingly stayed at a cabin on Bill and MF Johnson's Sabino Ranch back in the 90's brought out how the CLH crazy road signs had come to be. I had always thought Bill Johnson had come up with the signs, but it turned out to be Tex's idea to divert everyone's attention away from the poor road that linked Camp to the highway. I believe*

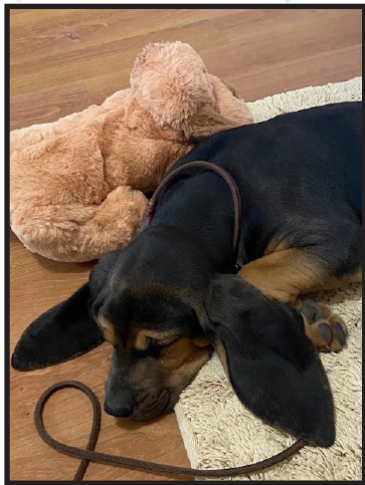
