We are so excited to say "Congratulations to Mo Heinrichs Shipp!!!!!! Mo is the next honoree for our famous CLASP tree ceremony to take place at Indian Springs this coming summer 2026! This summer will be Mo's 27th year at camp.....yes, 27!!!!!! Her camper years began 2nd Term 1990. In the years after she was Campfire Lighter, Favorite Camper, and then Favorite as a Counselor. Mo continues to work as an attorney while coming back to camp for a term each summer to be Hoss director with Sara Shelburn Hazlewood and in the girls camp with Keri, Norris and Karli. She also continues to be a cheerleader and promoter for everything CLH as you will read in her letter to follow. Her husband Barrett is right along her with that CLH Spirit. And now all three of their children will be campers this summer, Foster, Hattie, and Gage! We are soooooo proud of you Mo!



I clearly remember my CLH interview as if it were yesterday. My mom took me to Indian Springs where I met with Sally in the Chow Hall. We looked over onto the lake and I saw kids blobbing, swimming laps, and jumping off the Eyeful Tower. I couldn't wait to go to camp.

I grew up flipping through my mom's old CLH annuals from the 1960s. Some of them were the soft back versions with binding before they made the hard back version. I carefully turned the pages and saw the faces of so many longhorn boys and girls having a great time on Inks Lake and could not wait for my turn.

Then the time finally came - 2nd Term 1990. My parents drove me from San Antonio to Burnet that first year, although I rode the bus every subsequent year. I cried for a good deal of the drive, a bit nervous after a less-than-great overnight experience at a camp the summer before. My mom tried to convince me that this experience would be completely different and that yes, I would actually love it. My dad tells the story that he dropped me off crying and when he picked me up, I ran into his arms crying again. He turned to my mom and asked whether I had just cried for the last three weeks, feeling pretty terrible about leaving me in that situation. Of course the answer was no - this time I cried because I didn't want to leave.

Amber Allen became my very first friend at camp. When I showed up my first year Amber, a third year camper, was already there and clearly knew all the ropes. We were in the Appaloosa cabin, and the girls I met that first summer have continued to play huge roles in my life. Over the next several years, more girls joined our cabin and age group. Some of those still remain in some of my dearest friends today. There are so many memories as a camper that it's hard to pick just a few to share. One funny memory that comes to mind occurred my Bronco year (which was then the summer after fifth grade). I showed up and found that many of my friends had started shaving their legs during the school year. Wanting to fit in, I wrote to my mom and asked whether I could shave mine, too. I was too impatient to wait for her reply, and went ahead and shaved my legs, sitting on Broadway with my friends and using the hose to complete the job. A couple of days later I received a letter from my mom telling me no, I could not shave my legs yet and we would discuss it when I got home. I was so upset, thinking about the trouble I would face at the end of the term. I will never forget Abbie Wilson Giraud looking at me stone faced and saying - in the most perfect Abbie way - that I hadn't done that great of a job anyway so it would probably be okay. Abbie remained a dear friend through my entire camp experience. So many other memories have to do with everyday life at camp - singing as we walked from activity to activity; eating the best meals in the Chow Hall; sitting under the trees or by the rocks next to the Maverick and Arabian cabins talking with friends about life; and singing taps at Campfire or Church Mountain.



If I thought being a camper was fun, it was nothing compared to my years as a counselor. During a time of such significant mental and emotional growth, I am so blessed to have spent my summers at camp, surrounded by amazing men and women who always encouraged me to be my very best and whatever I did; to lead with grace and a servant's heart; and to be a team player. Nan, Bobby, Ashley MacKenna, and David and Stacy Bennett taught me to be a good employee and leader. Most leadership skills I have I learned from my time as a counselor and director at camp. I passed up on internship opportunities and travel opportunities in order to make sure camp fit into my summer schedule. I still believe it was one of the best decisions of my life.

I was a JC in 1997, and a counselor at least one term every summer from 1999 through 2005 (missing 1998). Third term 1999 I had the honor of being the assistant Hoss Director, and when I returned in 2000 I got the lead role. I had so many fun summers with Randy Shelburn, who served as a supporter and confidant. Second term 2000 I also had the honor of being a general with Sheridan Davies Bunch, Alan Baum, and Justin Daerr. Alan, Justin, and I had been friends since we were kids. I had met Sheridan the previous summer and immediately became close friends. Years later she became Godmother to my oldest child, Foster.

When I graduated from college and started looking for jobs, Layla Zafarnia Vela and I both found ourselves with job offers in Dallas. This was obviously a sign, and we immediately started looking for apartments. I couldn't believe it - I was actually going to be employed and I got to live with one of my best friends? Sign me up! Nine months later we upgraded from a two bedroom apartment to a three bedroom so that Meghan Rice Jones could move in with us, and boy did we have fun. Layla, Meghan and I had been friends since we were campers, and getting to live with them as young adults was such a blessing.

In 2005 I met Barrett Shipp. Barrett heard about camp early on - back when we were not yet dating and were close friends. I have always said that I am blessed to have found someone who may not love camp as much as I do, but he respects my love for it. Barrett spent summer weekends working at camp with me. He painted signs, cleaned libraries, and built campfires. At our rehearsal dinner, Sheridan Davies Bunch and Meagan Rice Jones presented Barrett with a few CLH essentials, including a plunger, of course, for library duty in our first apartment.

When Nan asked if I would consider coming back to work at camp as Hoss Director, I couldn't believe it. This really was the dream. I always said that my job at Hoss was the best job I ever had, so how could I say no? Thankfully Barrett was on board and I was able to work out an arrangement to work remotely for several weeks so I could say yes to this amazing opportunity. While it did not work out for 2020 as we planned (which we can all say for so many things!), I was ecstatic to come back in 2021. One of the most fun parts of being back at camp has been getting to know my friends' kids. As life goes on we all get busy, and when you don't live in the same city as someone you might not see them as often as you would like or get to know their families. It is always hilarious to have a camper come up to me and when they look at me I think "wow, I know you." I follow up asking "who are your parents?" And when they tell me, I respond with a huge smile, thinking "that makes sense."

I think most CLH alums have a moment when they become a parent that they think wow - my child is going to have the opportunity to experience heaven on earth at camp. In 2020, our oldest son, Foster, attended third term as a Rattlesnake Down. While his experience was different because #2020, he fell in love with camp. I have always been so thankful that Foster was able to have a camp experience that summer. Our daughter Hattie was a Pony Up in 2023, and Gage will be a Rattlesnake in 2026. All of my children have or will have friends whose parents played a huge role in my camp experience. It is so fun to see the generational effects of camp.



All of my memories are wonderful, but I wouldn't have the memories without the people. I am so thankful to those friends who have made camp what it is. I started to make a list of all of the people who have played a part in my camp experience, but found that the list was quite long and I was worried I would inadvertently leave someone out. So I have only named a few here, but know that if my path has crossed yours, that you have played a part in not only my story at camp but for all of those who have come after you. Thank you to all of the friends who have made camp what it is and who helped me become the person I am today, and thank you to camp for letting me continue my journey each summer!

CONGRATULATIONS MEG JONES!

Generations create a strong sense of community and continuity. For 86 years, Camp Longhorn has created a legacy that has been passed down among many generations. I had the privilege of being a second-generation camper, now raising third generation campers at one of the greatest places on earth.

To begin, my father Ralph "Red Dog" Jones began attending Longhorn when he was 10 years old in 1957. Not long after his parents put him on the Dallas bus, his sister Joanne Jones and brother Philip "Black Dog" Jones began their summer fun in the hill country. The Jones boys were hooked from day one, and after their camper days were over, every summer from their junior year in high school to after college graduation, was spent as counselors. While they were six years apart, you would have Red Dog or Black Pup at Longhorn until both of them eventually had to start practicing law. While the real world called Ralph and Philip, one thing to did leave with Philip- longtime camper and counselor, Claudia Clinton. They met at camp, and while the camp marriage in a canoe at carnival was made in holy macaroni, it became official in her hometown of Burnet in July 1977.

When it came time for me to head to the hills and dales as an 8-year-old in the summer of 1986, I was lucky to have parents who believed in the benefits of attending a summer camp. My mom had attended Camp Waldemar and my parents knew either camp experience would be a positive one. My parents signed me up for Camp Longhorn in 1986 as a 4th termmer. After my first summer, I asked for more time and my parents moved me to 2nd term, which was my home for 3 weeks every summer through Chief year. Little did I know at the time, my 9-year experience as a camper would lead to 6 years as counselor. After my Chief year, I served 14 terms as a counselor. And like my father and uncle, after working two terms after college graduation, I left camp for the last time to enter my next chapter of the working world. What I didn't know as a young working professional, the impact camp had on me in many ways beyond the camper/counselor experiences.

Camp Longhorn is about the friends. Friendships form in the most unexpected ways—over shared experiences, cabin time, activities, campfire, church mountain, and more. You might arrive as strangers, but within days, you're swapping outfits for dance night, sharing funny stories, and feeling like you've known your cabinmates





forever. Camp friends are special because they see you at your messiest and most honest—no phones, no filters, just real connection. Even if you only have two to three weeks together, those friendships feel big, like something you'll carry with you long after the campfires burn out. Relationships are very important to me and I found some of the closest ones at Camp Longhorn. At age 14, I met one of my best friends and lifelong partner of fun, Julie Storey Cothorn. Together, Camp Longhorn formed us and shaped us into what it meant to be a friend. Julie became my college roommate all through college and even after college in Dallas before she married Rob. Friendship is built on trust, kindness, and shared experiences that create a bond stronger than words. Julie and I to this day, travel with our families and she and Rob are the god parents to one of my children. As campers and then later as counselors, camp introduced me to the love of tradition, meaningful relationships, and to invest in others. I had many counselors who invested in me, Meredith Willingham Mabus, Kelly Blaylock Morton, Laura Barrow Thomason, and Hailey Ehtridge Bechtol to name a few. I looked up to many who came before me and knew that I wanted to lead like they led. Camp Longhorn creates friendships that are for a lifetime. It's not about how often you see each other, but how deeply you care and nurture those friendships.

Camp Longhorn is all about family. We can all say that the Robertson family has invested in each camper and counselor in some way. Pat and Tex began with a dream to build an environment that would foster unique experiences and create lifelong friendships. Camp Longhorn isn't just a place—it's a legacy. Passed down through generations of the same family, it carries with it the spirit of those who built it, led it, and loved it. From the handwritten signs to the recipes served in the chow hall, everything feels personal and rooted in tradition. You can sense the care in the way campers are welcomed, as if they're part of the extended family. At a time when so many places feel temporary or commercial, a family-run camp stands out as something rare and a lasting place where values are lived out, memories are made, and the past gently shapes the present. I look at the influence Girls Camp Directors, Carol and Bill Robertson had on my life. They become mentors who guided and inspired me. Their leadership goes beyond managing schedules; they model integrity in everything they do. Carol and Bill saw potential in me and others, and created a space where everyone grew in confidence. No matter when and for how long you attended Camp Longhorn, you have a family for life.

Looking back, I see how camp molded me into who I am today. Camp Longhorn taught me the value of someone's name. Learn people's names. Invest in people's lives. Camp taught the value of hard work. I have made a career in building relationships and friendships. My journey in fundraising and friendraising began in 2001 in the emotionally powerful environment of a children's hospital, where every dollar raised directly supported families receiving care. It taught me how to connect people to purpose and how to tell stories that move hearts and inspire action.

Over time, I realized that what drew me in wasn't just the mission—it was building relationships, fostering community, and creating long-term impact. That's what led me to the world of education in 2020. The shift to

education felt natural because both fields are rooted in care, communication, and making a difference in people's lives. Now, as a nonprofit Executive Director of an education foundation, I carry those same skills and values with me. I see education as another form of transformation, and I'm committed to advancing opportunities for teachers and students by building strong partnerships, deepening engagement, and championing a mission that shapes future generations.

CONGRATULATIONS BRADLEY BOYCE!

Trying to articulate the camp experience is the hardest thing any of us ever tries to do. We are simultaneously speechless and unable to stop talking about it. I never anticipated the trajectory my life would take simply because I said yes to summer camp in 2002. I've made some of the greatest friends, had some of the most memorable moments, and learned powerful lessons. It wasn't until this past summer that I really started thinking about the invisible string that has tied me to camp since 2002, but I haven't been able to get it off my mind ever since.

The story of how I ended up at CLH is a random one. My mother grew up knowing people who attended and always wanted to go, but her family couldn't afford it. When my sister and I got older, she decided to send us in



her place. Originally, we were signed up for 1st term Inks Lake but ended up on a wait list. Then, in early 2002, David Bennett called with two spots at 2nd term Indian Springs, if we were interested. Intent on going, we jumped at the opportunity. So, David mailed us a VHS copy of the camp movie, we wrote a letter explaining why we wanted to go, then we had a quick phone interview and the rest is history.

2nd Term 2002 (Roadrunner cabin) was my first summer at camp, and if you were there, you know...we got 22" of rain over 15 days. Barely any time in the lake, Mile Swim in the pool, Hoss Show on broomstick, and a "drive-thru" V-Day—it was less than an ideal term for anyone. And yet, I was struck by the magic of camp and signed up the second my early bird came in. I continued to return to 2nd Term Indian Springs for 5 additional summers as a camper until my term as a Ranger in 2007 which, poetically, is also remembered for its insane flood.

Early on, I knew I wanted to be a counselor. The counselors were always the most memorable part of my camp experience. We all remember thinking they were the coolest, most interesting people ever (which, truthfully, they were). I started my counselor journey as a 2nd term Hawk in 2008—the first of many terms in that cabin. I slowly started branching out into other terms until I was doing all

4, year after year. Early on I took an interest in Hoss, and was eventually given the opportunity to be the Hoss director beginning in 2011, and I continued doing it for many years. Getting the chance to work with Randy Shelburn for over 20 terms was one of the most fun experiences I've had. On paper, he and I couldn't be more different, but our senses of humor meshed perfectly and I enjoyed every minute of the time we spent on the trails, in the arena, and around camp. Eventually, the pull of boys' camp got me and I was able to be a general, a Wrangler counselor, go on a Ranger trip, and work as a division head for multiple terms. Leaving the corral after so long was difficult at first, but getting more involved in boys' camp allowed me to build new connections with people and strengthen existing ones.

When I started camp back in 2002, I never could've anticipated where it





would take me. I knew early on that I wanted to continue coming back as long as possible, but I never dreamed it would be something that I would still be so involved in after 23 summers. My sister and I started in 2002, but I was the only one who continued on the next year. I had two brothers, Britton and Brylee, born in 2003 and 2006, respectively (the latter while I was at camp as a Wrangler camper). My mom always said I had to keep coming back until Britton started camp so I could be there to check up on him. Britton was

a 1st term Rattlesnake Up in 2012. It was an easy promise to make, but I “knew” I would never see Brylee as a camper in 2015. Luckily, I was fortunate enough to not only see both of them through all 9 summers, but I was able to work with Britton during his 2 summers as a counselor. The invisible string that connected me to camp beginning in 2002 isn’t a single, uninterrupted connection, but rather one with countless branches tying all of us together. Everyone who feels deeply connected to camp is on the same string, whether we know one another or not. It all started when Tex had the idea for Camp Longhorn all those years ago, which set off a chain of events that led each of us to the place we are today. Somehow, we all find ourselves connected to the string thanks to someone else, and we unknowingly tie it to those we find along the way. It’s something that I think happens the moment you truly embrace the magic of camp. Then, once you share that magic with someone else, you extend the string. I will be forever grateful for the relationships I have had the opportunity of building at camp, and the ways you’ve changed me for the better.

Camp Longhorn proudly supports recent Texas legislative efforts aimed at enhancing safety across all camps in the state. Camper safety has always been our highest priority throughout our 86 summers. With the passage of SB 1 (Youth Camp Safety Act), HB 1 (Heaven's 27 Act), and other measures, we will be implementing several new layers of safety protocols and communication enhancements designed to add to our existing robust safety measures.

We are deeply grateful to our campers who donated Merits toward flood relief, and to those who purchased the "Camp Strong" caps this summer. They sold out in record time. 100% of the proceeds went directly to The Community Foundation of the Texas Hill Country Camp Recovery Fund. This summer, Camp Longhorn families contributed a total of \$24,191 to the fund, \$10,857 of which generously came from campers' merit contributions:

This fall we reached out and asked our Camp Longhorn families to support this effort and we are so pleased that as of October 10th another \$19,561.00 has been generously raised, with Camp Longhorn matching this amount! This will make a huge impact supporting the Hill Country camps in need.

"I find the work I do as a school counselor to be challenging almost every day," Richter said. "I am quick to recognize that parents entrust their treasures, their children, to us at school — and the business of understanding and caring for people is always nuanced and of utmost importance."

Richter began providing support for children in her first job as a camp counselor at Camp Longhorn. CLH Memories

Memories of Camp Longhorn Summers - by CHARLIE BRADEN

I stepped onto Camp Longhorn at Inks Lake for the first time in June of 1967 at 9 years of age and was assigned to Cabin 4 ½ Foxes for the 1st Term. My cabin counselors were Kenno Tarlton, Pat Lochridge, and Jeff Gray. I am sure this trifecta had little knowledge at the time that they would one day join the pantheon of all-time great CLH counselors – certainly for that era and perhaps in CLH history. What a start! We had a lot of fun.

What followed were several more years of wonderful counselors including legends like Paul Clark and Ralph "Poo" Cousins. These were just my cabin counselors and do not include the many other charismatic and larger-than-life individuals at camp – too many to even attempt to name. To a young boy like me, these men exemplified leadership, positivity, and confidence – great qualities to be exposed to. At the same time, however, they were watching each camper like a big brother to make sure that our experience was positive as well. Back then, camp terms were 3 weeks long, maybe more. For the young ones, it was usually the longest time they had been away from home, so the counselors kept us busy and on the move.

And there was Tex and Pat, Bill and M.F., Bob Tarlton, Helen and Ray Frady, Zark and Lorena, and all the Robertson and Johnson family members and those behind the scenes that kept camp humming.

In those 60's and 70's Vietnam War years the camp had a military vibe with discipline, positive reinforcement, liberal use of surplus goods and the creative know-how to make almost anything out of nothing. Being the OD was an honor and earning a Merit made you proud. If you let the cabin screen door shut too loudly that earned you a D and taught you to think.

Later, after my first year in the Foxes cabin, I was in cabin 8 Bobcats, 10 Jaguars, Tarpons and Wrangler. Deep in the closet hangs my 3rd year jacket with all the patches, and just below that the grand prize 22 caliber rifle I won on the spinning wheel at Houston Carnival.

After my Wrangler year, I was looking forward to being a Counselor in Training (CIT), however in the winter of 1973 I was a passenger in a terrible automobile accident and suffered multiple limb fractures. I was hospitalized for 6 weeks and spent that spring and summer in a wheelchair and crutches recuperating. I would not make it to that CIT summer. Not to be forgotten by the CLH family, Ray Frady paid a visit while I was in the hospital in Houston. I have never forgotten that kind gesture.

I eventually recovered and rounded out my years at Camp Longhorn as a counselor in Cabin 7 Beavers and Cabin 3 Comanches passing along CLH lore to great campers.

My memories of camp are less a story and more a series of images in my head – Images like:

The Mile Swim. The Trolley at Swim Bay. Blobbing. Frog Day. Lighting the Campfire and smelling the cedar burn. Corny but funny campfire skits (a boy in an army helmet comes running on stage holding up a twig yelling "the infant tree is coming; the infant tree is coming!") Getting married at Carnival. Fun Day (cowboys forever). The hidden underwater "cave" by the Tarpon cabin. Dynamiting sailboats.

The Gum Drop from a Fort Hood helicopter. A loaded comic book rack. Tetherball. Morning inspection – tuck that shirt in, comb your hair, brush your teeth, and clean your fingernails. End-of-day alcohol in the ears to prevent infection. Evening health checks to verify regular bodily functions. After dinner merit questions. Reading the funny signs upon arriving at camp by bus ("Don't take this rock for granite"). And when leaving ("So Longhorn").

Church Mountain. Hearing your name on the loudspeaker being called to Mass at Tex and Pat's house on Sunday. Dr. Joe and Fayro at the Pit Stop. The "One and Only" Merit Store. "Bawth" Day. Thursday Dance Night on the girls' tennis courts (ladies' choice!) with Aretha Franklin belting out R-E-S-P-E-C-T or slow-dancing to the Moody Blues' Nights in White Satin (Google it young ones).

Saturday movie night at Campfire. Tex and Pat's Olympic pool with a window. L.T. and Barney's Chow Hall "Take all you want but eat all you take!" 4th year canoe trip down the dam. 5th year trip on horseback for a sunrise breakfast. Ralph's Poo (honey) Butter on campfire biscuits. Latrine duty. KP duty. Wrangler Driving School. Bob Tarlton at campfire in dim light with leathery skin and a cigarette dangling from his lips telling tales in his deep voice. All you could see was that ember and the images he created in your mind. I still remember his encounter with a bobcat as he showed us the scar on his arm. What a storyteller!

Guich Koock and the Camp Zoo. Making your bed every morning – "I better be able to bounce a dime on it." Old Facefull water fountains. Water skiing after supper or going to the Bluebonnet Tavern on counselor off nights. Most of all, making friends from all over and forming the best memories that you cannot forget.

A final thought about the worldly outcome of the Camp Longhorn experience, at least for me – all the campers and counselors were from rural towns and cities large and small, and we all shared the same experience. During my time most were from Texas, Oklahoma, Arkansas, or Louisiana and other neighboring states. Far flung places as well. To this day, I will hear mention of a small town on the news and often say "I had a Camp Longhorn cabinmate from there!" God bless us all.

I want to extend my deepest gratitude for your incredible care, communication, and leadership during the devastating flooding. As a parent, it is hard to find the right words to express how much your constant updates and calm, thoughtful handling of the situation meant to me and my family.

Most of all, I want to thank you for loving and protecting my daughter, Coconut. She came home full of stories, laughter, and the kind of confidence only Camp Longhorn can instill. When she told me about the lifesaving activities you taught them, I broke down in tears. It hit me that she was not only having fun, she was learning something profound, something that could one day save a life. What an extraordinary gift.

From the bottom of my heart, thank you for giving her those core memories, for showing her what resilience and community look like, and for creating a space where she feels safe, empowered, and celebrated. We truly could not be happier with our decision to send her to Camp Longhorn. She had an amazing time this summer and is already counting the days until she returns next year.

James "Jimmy" Wilson Wooten

James "Jimmy" Wilson Wooten passed away on the 15th of July 2025, at the age of 68, in Houston, Texas, after a short but courageous fight with an aggressive form of cancer. His beloved wife of 44 years, Melinda, was by his side.

Jimmy was born on the 18th of November 1956, in Houston, the youngest of four boys — he would later joke that his mother cried in the hospital because he was "supposed" to be a girl. Jimmy loved growing up in their rambunctious house, and their funny and often wild adventures became family legends for his children, nieces and nephews. Did they really waterski behind the jeep in the flooded roadside ditches of their neighborhood?

Jimmy graduated from Lee High School, after first meeting Melinda on a Young Life ski trip. Together, they attended the University of Texas, where he earned his bachelor's degree in architectural engineering.

Jimmy and Melinda married at St. Martin's Episcopal Church in Houston on the 31st of January 1981. They soon moved to Austin where Jimmy began his career with his brother Bryan, developing commercial properties. While in Austin they welcomed their son, Robert, in 1984, and their daughter, Ellen, in 1986. In 1988, Jimmy, Melinda, and their two children returned to Houston, where he built a career as a homebuilder and contractor.

An avid outdoorsman, Jimmy loved bird hunting in South Texas and fishing on the Texas coast. He rarely passed up the chance to ski — water or snow — and even in his later years, could out-ski just about anyone, despite what his brothers may contend. A defining part of his childhood was summers at Camp Longhorn, where he was a lifetime camper and later a counselor. Now he can smile down on his grandchildren as they follow in this family tradition. Nothing brought Jimmy more joy than time spent with Melinda, their children, and his beloved grandchildren, Davey (11), Reid (8), Wade (7), Wyatt (5), and Ryan (2) — especially at their second home in Port O'Connor, Texas.

Jimmy was the kind of man who made everyone feel at ease. He leaves behind a big family and countless friends who will remember him for his quiet and often quirky sense of humor, kindness, and the way he made life feel just a little more fun.

Jimmy is preceded in death by his parents, Jim and Lou Wooten, and his sister-in-law, Sherri. He is survived by Melinda; their son, Robert (Jennifer), and daughter, Ellen Dixon (Max); grandchildren, Davey, Reid, Wade, Wyatt, and Ryan; and brothers Bryan, Harris (Jill), and Timm (Suzanne). Other surviving family members include his sister-in-law Patty Brown (Mont), as well as many loving nieces, nephews, and extended family, who each held a special place in Jimmy's heart.

A devoted husband, loving father, astute businessman, and dedicated humanitarian, Malcolm touched countless lives through his friendship, mentorship, and great sense of humor.

A fourth-generation Houstonian, Malcolm was born on the 25th of May 1952, to Norrie Jane Moore Waddell and John Malcolm Waddell Sr., joining his older sister, Candace. A proud Kinkaid School "lifer," Malcolm graduated in 1970 before earning a B.A. in Economics and Managerial Studies from Rice University in 1974. He went on to receive an MBA from Harvard University in 1979. Each of these institutions shaped his character and values and served as the foundation for lifelong friendships.

During the summer between his years at Harvard, friends introduced Malcolm to Suzanne Bruce, a second-year medical student at Baylor College of Medicine. The two quickly fell in love and married in 1981. They welcomed daughters Julianne and Amanda, and Malcolm embraced fatherhood. After the sale of his company in 1993, Malcolm became a full-time, self-proclaimed "Mr. Mom," a role he cherished long before it was common. A familiar face at school functions and homeroom cupcake runs, these moments were not chores to him, but privileges. Time with his daughters was his greatest joy.

Malcolm's entrepreneurial spirit emerged early in his career. In 1984, he co-purchased the company that would become EnClean, Inc., where he served as CEO for a decade. Following its sale in 1993, Malcolm devoted his energy to his family before launching a new business partnership with Suzanne in 1997. Together, they grew Suzanne Bruce and Associates Dermatology from a solo practice into a thriving multi-practitioner medical, research and cosmetic clinic. As a mentor to SBA's young managers, Malcolm helped to shape many careers with his thoughtful guidance.

Beyond his professional life, Malcolm found joy in music, travel, friends, and volunteerism. A living music encyclopedia, he could name every hit from the 60's and 70's after just a few notes and was a frequent winner of Houston KLDE radio's "name that tune" contest (before being banned from competing). For forty years, he created mix tapes, CDs and finally USBs of Christmas music that he handed out to not only friends and neighbors, but also employees at some of his favorite local restaurants. He loved spending time at the family vacation homes in New Mexico and Galveston. Always curious and eager to explore every corner of the world, he and Suzanne enjoyed many wonderful trips together.

Whether recounting the history of Motown or engaging in heartfelt conversation, Malcolm was a social butterfly. Known as a uniter of people, he enthusiastically served as his Kinkaid class correspondent for over thirty years. As a child, he spent many happy summers at Camp Longhorn and even attended Alumni Camp as an adult. He particularly enjoyed reconnecting with his Harvard section mates during their monthly Zoom calls.

Malcolm was committed to serving his community. He held many leadership positions, including President of the Kinkaid Alumni Association and the Jones School's Rice Business Partners, and served as a board member for the Houston Area Women's Center. He and Suzanne have been members of Christ the King Lutheran Church since 1981, and in his final days, he often turned to his faith for strength and comfort. (cont'd) >>>>>>>>

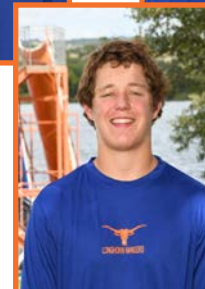
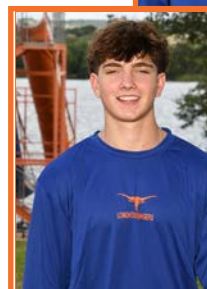

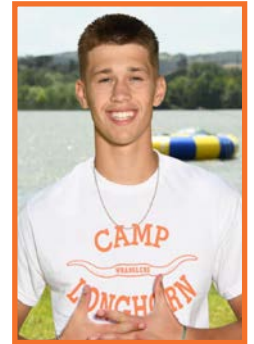
