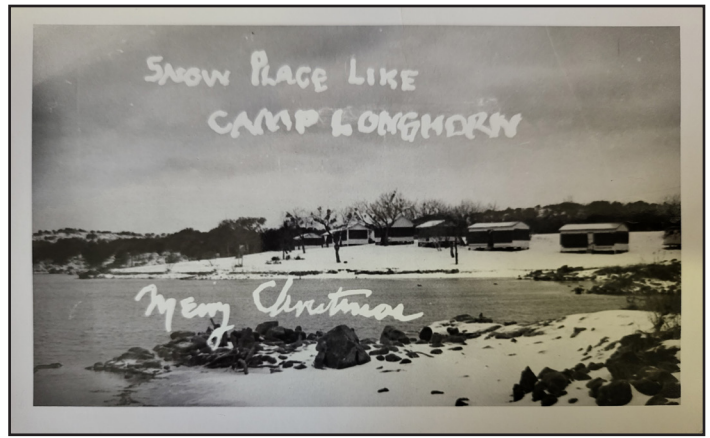

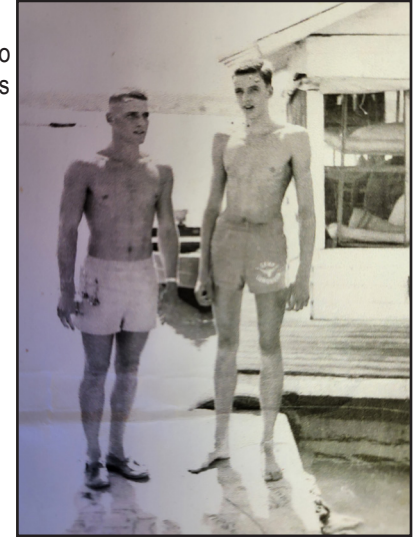

During the winter months, she spends time thinking up new recipes and is also Employee Coordinator. C3 favorites . . . THANK YOU, BETH!

Tater Tot Casserole:

Yields a 9x13 baking dish

Ingredients:

2 lbs. ground beef

1 large can cream of mushroom (or homemade)

Onion powder (to taste)

Garlic powder (to taste)

Shredded cheddar

Frozen tater tots

Prep:

Brown ground beef, drain. Add in seasonings and soup, mix well. Spread into a greased 9x13 baking dish and top with tater tots. Bake at 350 until tots are golden brown. Top with cheese and return to oven until cheese is melted. ENJOY!

Oreo Pudding:

Ingredients:

Chocolate pudding

Whip cream

Crushed Oreos

Prep:

Mix equal amounts of pudding and whipped cream (amounts depend on how much you need), stir in crushed Oreos then top with more Oreos. Chill and ENJOY!

Chicken & Rice Soup:

Ingredients:

Shredded chicken (rotisserie works great)

Rice, uncooked about 2 cups

Medium yellow onion, chopped

3 cloves fresh garlic, minced

1 lb. carrots

1 large bunch celery

Dried or fresh parsley

Chicken broth

Olive oil

Salt, pepper, season salt (to taste)

Prep:

In a large stock pot sauté chopped onion in oil until tender, add minced garlic and sauté 30 seconds more. Add broth, chicken, seasonings, and veggies and cook until veggies are about 80% done. Add rice, when cooked...ENJOY!

Chicken & Dumplings:

Measurements for a large stock pot

Ingredients:

Flour

Biscuits (I like frozen pucks). Hard to say how many...eye it

Dried or fresh parsley

Chicken broth (amount depends on size of your pot)

Pepper

Shredded Chicken (rotisserie works great)

Season salt

Prep:

In a large bowl combine flour, seasoning, and parsley. Thaw biscuits partially (or use can biscuits) and cut into at least 9 pieces each, small chunks. Roll biscuit chunks in flour immediately and set aside in another bowl, flour in the bottom so they do not stick. (I like to add some of the seasoned flour in between layers to keep from sticking as well) Continue until all done. Bring chicken broth and chicken to a rolling boil, add biscuits in by the handful....extra flour will make it in and that is good because it will help thicken the broth. Reduce heat just a little and cook at least 25 min or until dough is cooked. Stirring very often. They will want to stick at the bottom so make sure to stir well. Add salt and pepper to taste. ENJOY!

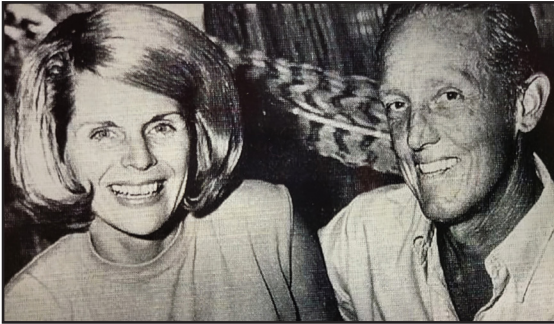

Ran into Vic recently, and we reminisced about camp and the wonderful times we had there. Jeff and I were known to short sheet Vic's bed, or even put large amounts of June Bugs in there, but Vic would retaliate, by turning on the sprinklers, outside our cabin screen next to our bunks. We still laugh about those great times today. Drew Lydick is another example of lifelong friends!

I was privileged to be at camp with MF and Bill Johnson, Bob Tarleton(watching the glow of the cigarette as he told his famous stories), Zark, Helen and Ray Frady, and of course, Tex and Pat. If this shows my age, I was even there when the main camp had horseback riding. After attending the camp carnivals each Winter, I would start counting down the days to camp. You knew it was just around the corner.

Anyway, I could go on and on, but wanted to list some memories that stood out over the years:

After the Water Show, counselors would jump off the rift raft, after they had lit a fuse of dynamite, and swam for their lives, as it would blow up seconds later. Don't think that would fly today!

Pat Lochridge wrestling the alligator during campfire.

Jack Ragsdill landing his plane on Inks Lake to pick up his son, Sam, on V Day. Repelling down the dam.

Me stealing a watermelon, from the Chow Hall, only to get caught by Barney. He threw me over his shoulder and locked me in the kitchen walk-in refrigerator. I was only nine and loved every minute of it. Don't think we could get away with that today!

Hacky Sack during the early 80's. Richie Rich comic books.

The BB(Joann !), and Thumper in the back room, listening to George Straight on the jukebox.

The Summer of 1983, I was extremely fortunate to have some of the best kids, all in one cabin, and I believe had nine campfire lighters just in that cabin alone.

I taught JJ Davis how to do a standing back flip, that he showed his parents on V Day. That was really special. The old army helicopter that would park on the baseball field, prior to the gum drop.

Pistol Love's Water Moccasin bite, in the canoe bay, late one night.

Hal Tinbrook, and eventually, Billy Pridham, commandeering the sailing tower. Counselors Bob Kingman, Larry Taylor, Frank Everest, Kevin Dolan, and Scott Johnson.

Robby Rob hiding in the trees, making sure counselors weren't drunk, when they had to sign-in at curfew. The tiny cabins, way back in the day, that were probably no more than 12' by 16', but slept 15 kids and counselors in bunk beds that hung from the ceiling.

A June Bug that crawled down Bobby Ferguson's ear canal one night. Kind of gross, but still a favorite memory. I believe he still has that June Bug in a jar to this day.

The Ramble Booth, which the wranglers and counselors had control of, during the 60's and 70's, spinning old 45s.

The Milkshake, old alums will know.
